

Payment Plans

Registration Fee:

\$31.50 (includes G.S.T.) per student or \$42.00 (includes G.S.T.) per family. Please enclose this fee with your registration form. Registration fees are non refundable.

Tuition Fees:

Tuition fees are assessed from September 10, 2011 to June 17, 2012. The payment system is for customer convenience and bears no relationship to the number of classes in any given month.

We accept four methods of payment:

1. Post dated cheques September through June.
2. Yearly Fee in advance.
3. Yearly Fee broken into two payments in advance. September through January, February through June.
4. Yearly Fee broken into three payments in advance. September through December, January through March, April through June.

Note: Master Card and VISA will be honored on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th methods of payment.

If for any reason you must withdraw from a class or from the school during the season, a refund (or return of your post-dated cheques) will be made upon written notice from you 30 days prior to withdrawal.

There are no refunds for missed classes however, students do have the option of taking an extra class to make up for the lesson missed if another class at the same level is offered.

Cheques which are returned to the school N.S.F. etc., will be subject to a charge of \$20.00.

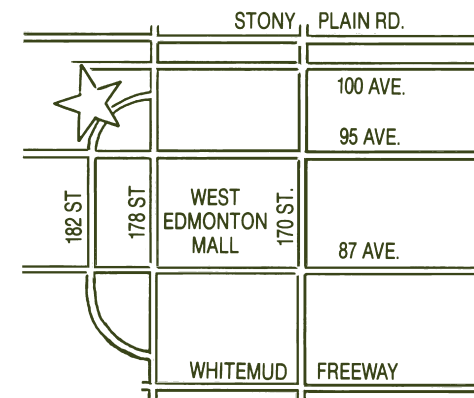

Classes - Ballet

Pre Pre School - Our three (3) year old dancers will discover the beauty, excitement and enjoyment of dance. Creative movement combined with musicality, rhythm and a sense of self-expression will inspire and encourage our youngest dancers to begin to love dance.

Length of lesson: 30 minutes/week

Pre School - Our four (4) year olds will continue to explore balletic movement and will achieve increased balance, coordination, awareness, strength, and the ability to move individually and to cooperate and relate within a group. Dance basics increase as we move forward with age-appropriate steps, songs and creative movement loved by these eager young dancers.

Length of lesson: 45 minutes/week

Primary Ballet - Our program for five (5) year olds is designed to reinforce the magical connection between the love of movement and the joy of artistic creativity. Simple ballet steps, incorporating skipping, running, jumping, and many basics of actual ballet steps are introduced in a positive, interesting and imaginative way to instill the love of dance.

Length of lesson: 45 minutes/week

Ballet - A sound foundation in the Cecchetti Method of classical ballet allows our students to progress through the ESB Junior Grades or Foundations program and into the actual Cecchetti Syllabus and exam work. Our non-syllabus classes focus on the study of classical technique, strength, posture, placement, movement and the love and enjoyment of ballet. Competition and recreational classes are available from beginner to advanced levels.

Length of lesson:

Junior Grades: 1 hour/week

Intermediate to Senior Students: 1½ to 3 hours/week

Cecchetti Ballet Exam Class

The Cecchetti method is an internationally recognized system of classical ballet training, endorsed by the ISTD, London, England; the Cecchetti Society of Canada and Cecchetti International. Exam classes are for those serious students who wish to concentrate on increased levels of technique and artistry. Classes will cover an in-depth study and are based on

the international syllabi set out by the Cecchetti Society. Dancers are expected to achieve at a high level of proficiency. We are proud to offer classes in both the Cecchetti Grades and Standards systems, which allows for appropriate placement of most serious students based on their individual capabilities. Exams are available in both streams. Students must have passed Junior 4 and be registered in Junior 5 or higher to begin any Cecchetti exam classes.

Length of lesson:

Grades and Standards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 - 1¼ hours/week

Grade 6, Intermediate, Advanced -
minimum 3 to 4½ hours/week.

Pre-Pointe - This safe introduction to the study of pointe work concentrates on specific exercises designed to promote the strength and understanding of the technical demands required for this specialized area of classical ballet. Students must have attained a minimum of Gr. 4 Cecchetti, at a high standard and be technically and physically prepared for this work. For the safety and well-being of our students, correct posture, strength and physical attributes are assessed by the teaching faculty prior to students starting pointe work.

Length of lesson: 45 minutes per week

Pointe Technique Class - Offered to intermediate and senior ballet students only. Course concentrates on more advanced skills and continued development of strength and technique.

Length of lesson: 1 hour/week

Classes - Jazz

Primary Jazz - (for children 5/6 years old). This is an introduction to the basic skills of jazz.

Length of lesson: 45 minutes/week

Jazz - Jazz is a fast paced class that focuses on jazz technique and stylized choreography. The classes are fun and energetic and are guaranteed to keep you moving. Festival work is available for interested students.

Length of lesson: Jr. Students 1 hour/week

Inter. & Adv. Students 1¼ hours/week

Lyrical - This combination of jazz and ballet technique portrays an emotion or story based on feeling or style. Students must be registered in one other ballet and jazz class and must be 12 years or older.

Length of lesson: 1 hour/week

Classes - Tap

Primary Tap - (for children 5/6 years old). This is an introduction to the basic skills of tap.

Length of lesson: 45 minutes/week

Tap - We have classes for all levels from beginner to professional. Festival work and exams are available for interested students.

Length of lesson: 1 hour/week

Classes - Hip Hop

Hip Hop - This exciting, fast-paced form of musical expression originated in the 1970's. The culture of hip hop has spread around the world both in music and dance and is very popular with all ages. Dancers will learn the many diverse dance styles authentic to this street dance culture. Students are encouraged to develop their own sense of style and rhythm through the physical expression of the varied choreography, freestyle, and training techniques they will study throughout the year in these exhilarating classes. Students must be 8 years or older to start.

Length of lesson: Beginner/Junior - 45 minutes/week

Inter. & Adv. Students - 1 hour/week

Other Courses

Following are other courses offered by the Lecky School of Dancing. Sign up sheets will be posted in the Fall. Fees charged for these extra courses are not included in the Fee Schedule & Cap. Fees will be subject to G.S.T.

Stretch and Technique - We encourage our students to improve their technique through special exercises developed to increase flexibility and improve stability and strength. This is especially important for students who wish to enter Competition Classes. This class will not be involved in a Festival/Recital Dance therefore no costume will be required.

Yearly Fee \$150.00 + GST

Musical Theatre - (for children ages 7 and up). Classes will begin in December and run through to mid May. A pre-requisite for this class will be one ballet class and one jazz class per week, registered at our school. The student must have completed two years in at least one of the above disciplines. A sign up sheet for this course will be posted in the Fall.

Yearly Fee \$250.00 + GST

Adult Classes

We will offer 10 week courses in Tap and Hip-Hop depending on interest.

Course Fee: \$130.00 + GST

Private Lessons

These may be booked with individual teachers in half hour or hourly sessions.

Solos, duets etc. for festival work are also subject to specific choreography fees.
